**At the Interface of the Brain and

Dr. Rosso leads the Brain, Environment, Aging, and Mobility (BEAM) lab. Her research aims to improve mobility of older adults, reducing disability and keeping individuals in their communities. It combines advanced methodologies in neuroimaging, gait analysis, neighborhood assessment, and longitudinal epidemiology to determine mechanisms of mobility decline and inform future intervention research. Dr. Rosso earned both her doctoral and master's degrees in epidemiology from Drexel University.
